Question: The original contract period has 26 cycles, which seems correct since the contract period does not begin until after May, however 26 cycles for Option Years #1-#4 seem to be too few for the mowing season in Kansas (Not later than April 1 – Nov 11 Veterans Day Holiday).

See Revised Price Schedule and quantities.

Question: What is included in the Scope of Work for CLIN xx24 *“Storm damage, clean up”*? Is it limited to “tree removal” from storms (as is CLIN xx18)?

This would include branch clean-up, tree removal and any tree pruning/shaping as needed due to storm

Question: The Federal Wage Rate of over \$18.00/hr (incl Health & Welfare) seems very high for rural Kansas. Is this the correct Wage Rate?

You must use the current prevailing wage rates, that is only an example listed in the solicitation.

Question: Section 3.5.2 “Flat Marker Blade Edging” of the SOW states, *“Metal blades shall NOT be used to edge around flat markers.”* Our commercial equipment suppliers are not aware of any alternative blades that are manufactured for use with edgers that are available in the marketplace. Can you recommend a specific product or supplier of alternative edger blades?

NO, they have to use metal blades....

Questions: Section 3.7.3 “Sod Requirements” of the SOW states, *“Contractor will be responsible for ensuring that the ground is at the proper grade. . . ”* Is the Contractor responsible for importing topsoil to level gravesites prior to the installation of sod, or will suitable fill material be available on site for the Contractor’s use?

There will be topsoil on site for the contractor to use

Also stated is: *“Installation will not be considered completed in its entirety, until sod has been rolled and irrigating sequence has been initiated and the newly installed sod has been inspected and accepted by the COR.”* LWNC and FLWNC do not have irrigation. Is the Contractor responsible for the continual watering of newly sodded gravesites until new sod is established?

Yes

If the Contractor is responsible for continual watering, are water spigots available for the Contractor's access to water in each section, or must the Contractor import water (by truck) for this task? And, what is this "establishment period"? (i.e., 30 days?)

Water spigots are on site and established turf is turf that has rooted and able to be mowed.
Time is dependent on weather condition. Usually NTE 60 days

Will the schedule for sod installation be limited to the cool spring (April-May) months and fall (Sept-Oct) months, or is the Contractor expected to maintain a weekly/monthly schedule throughout the hot summer months also?

They will be required to maintain weekly schedule but also depends on number of burials that they will do.

Question: A chemical supplier warns that phosphate and potash has the potential to stain marble headstones and asks if 28-0-0 is an acceptable product to substitute?

We've had no problems with headstone staining from phosphate or potash. What is specified in the contract should be used. Fertilizers that contain iron should not be used because of staining issues.

Question: Section 3.10.1 regarding "Herbicide for Broadleaf Weeds" states, "*Spraying of all turfgrass areas shall be done **TWICE** each year, in early-mid May . . . and in October to have maximum effect . . .*." However, CLINs xx16 and xx22 only allow pricing for **ONE** such spraying. [Bold added] Which is correct?

Agreed See Revised Price Schedule.

Question: Item #7 of the Services Delivery Summary (SDS) states the "Minimum Acceptable Level (MAL)" of results for Herbicide Applications as: "*The Cemetery is generally weed free and weed population does not distract from the overall appearance of the Cemetery. Proper herbicide is applied in such a manner as to bring about the total control of all broadleaf and grassy weeds in the improved turf areas of the Cemetery. **Repeat, follow-up, and/or spot spray herbicide applications, as needed, have been applied.***" [Bold added] Since most herbicide manufacturers/suppliers recommend more than just two post-emergent sprayings for this region to achieve maximum weed control (and since this is an IDIQ contract) will the Contractor be paid for additional spray applications if required, or must the Contractor incorporate the costs for these additional spray applications (which will most likely be required to achieve minimum standards) into his costs?

If the product calls for more than one application to be effective the contractor should figure that in. But if a product calls for one application they figure that cost. If spot applications are required after we can do that in-house

The Contractor would be required to repeat an application at their cost if the weed control failed because of improper application (such as a poorly calibrated or operated sprayer or if not enough herbicide was used). To the point of needing more than two sprays for broadleaf weeds, the sulfentrazone plus quinclorac herbicide mixture applied in June for nutsedge control will also provide good control of most broadleaf weeds, so there are really three broadleaf sprays each year.

Question: Most National Cemeteries which are located on military facilities have strict background checks and deny entry to workers who are non-citizens or to anyone with a criminal background. Is this the situation with Fort Leavenworth National Cemetery (36 acre site)? Is it located on the military facility behind the security checkpoint?

Per the SOW it states that the employees working on FTLNC are required to have the background checks. And yes they need it.
