3. Description of Supplies or Services: KR-1W Wavefront Auto Ref/Ker/Top with copy of viewer software that will be used in the new Healthcare Center (HCC) Optometry Clinic.

The estimated value of the proposed action is \$ 52,456.00

The 5-in-1 KR-1W Wave-front boasts the combined technologies of wave-front aberration, corneal topography and auto-refraction. The system features full auto-alignment, a large color touch screen, onboard evaluation software, wave-front image sequence and simulated visual acuity assessment. The KR-1W provides the eye care professional with all the required information on the human refractive system to perform optimal wave-front analysis.

In the interest of economy and efficiency, the new work is a logical follow-on to an original Federal Supply Schedule order and the original order was placed in accordance with the applicable Federal Supply Schedule ordering procedures. 5. Rational/explanation to support cited authority: VA Butler currently has no method of measuring corneal irregularity or to perform wavefront analysis in cases of keratoconus, irregular astigmatism, post op corneal transplant patients, post op refractive surgery patients, ocular trauma, unexplained vision loss, and other corneal diseases. The KR-1W combines the technology needed for such cases into one unit that combines aberrometry, topography, keratometry, pupillometry and autorefraction all in one unit instead of 5 separate pieces of equipment. Space allocated for the eye clinic at the new HCC is limited. Five separate pieces of equipment would require more equipment tables to be purchased and more rooms than are available for the eye clinic to utilize. Having one piece of equipment that performs 5 functions saves money and space and in the best interest of the government.. The KR-1W is the only autorefractor on the market that combines 5 functions into one machine aberrometry, topography, keratometry, pupillometry and autorefraction that is Dicom compliant, to be incorporated into the VA approved FORUM software. The software associated with this piece of equipment is going to be FORUM which is tying different pieces of ophthalmic equipment together so all information can be uploaded into Vista and CPRS. Following is the interface, gateway and implementation for the FORUM package.

Single FORUM archive implementation on Zeiss supplied server. Interface (1) HFA 3 Field Analyzer, (1) Cirrus Photo 800, (1) Optos California, (1) B-scan ultrasound, (1) Topcon KR-1W, (2) Zeiss SL 120 Slit Lamp CAM Anterior Segment imaging system to FORUM via Modality Worklist/DICOM Gateway or LinkNet. Transfer HFA and Cirrus raw data to FORUM. Implement FORUM Gluacoma Workplace & HFA/Cirrus combined report. In FGW, create SFA reports for all prior HFA tests. Implement FORUM Retina Workplace. Implement Cirrus Review into FORUM datatbase. Interface with CPRS EHR system and provide data forwarding to Vista Imaging. Provide (5) simultaneous FORUM viewers for exam rooms and staff workstation.
