






-  Existing Fire Extinguisher

1. See cover sheet for applicable code information.
2. Contractor shall inform Architect and Owner immediately of any discrepancies in the drawing related wall construction and non-conforming penetrations.
3. Project scope line is indicated for general intent only. Contractor will complete all work regardless if it is located outside of project scope area as indicated on any drawing.
4. Travel distances are from remote point to exit.
5. Provide firestopping at all penetrations through new and existing fire/smoke rated barriers (walls and floors) to comply with required rating associated with new and existing firestopping around 12 penetrations less than 16 inches square, 10 penetrations between 16 and 36 square inches, and 8 penetrations between 36 and 144 square inches. Provide fire/smoke rated barriers (walls and floors) to comply with required rating associated with new work. Larger openings shall be brought to the immediate attention of the COFR.

- 1 Existing fire dampers at floor to remain.
- 2 Extend existing partition to underside of deck.
