

**JUSTIFICATION FOR SINGLE SOURCE AWARDS IAW [VAAR 819.7007](#)
 (OVER MICRO-PURCHASE THRESHOLD(\$3.5K) BUT NOT EXCEEDING THE SAT (\$150K))**

819.7007 Sole source awards to service-disabled Veteran-owned small business concerns.

- (a) A contracting officer may award contracts to SDVOSB concerns on a sole source basis provided:
- (1) The anticipated award price of the contract (including options) will not exceed \$5 million;
 - (2) The requirement is synopsised in accordance with FAR part 5;
 - (3) The SDVOSB concern has been determined to be a responsible contractor with respect to performance; and
 - (4) Award can be made at a fair and reasonable price.
- (b) The contracting officer's determination whether to make a sole source award is a business decision wholly within the discretion of the contracting officer. A determination that only one SDVOSB concern is available to meet the requirement is not required.
- (c) When conducting a SDVOSB sole source acquisition, the contracting officer shall ensure businesses are registered and verified as eligible in the VIP database prior to making an award.

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2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF SUPPLIES OR SERVICES REQUIRED AND THE INTENDED USE:

The Fargo VAMC surgery service line is requesting a GlideScope Titanium Video Laryngoscope with spectrum smart cables.

3. UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS THAT LIMIT AVAILABILITY TO ONLY ONE SOURCE, WITH THE REASON NO OTHER SUPPLIES OR SERVICES CAN BE USED:

The Fargo VAMC is requesting an exact match to a Verathon spectrum smart cable, spectrum SU, LoPro S3 and Spectrum SU, LoPro S4. The reason for this brand-name requirement is that the Fargo VAMC currently utilizes Verathon video monitors. The cabling and software that currently exists within the facility is specific to Verathon and due to the environment in which these items will be used (surgery) it is imperative that the facility only uses matching brand name (Verathon) approved items. Failure to maintain brand integrity could spell disaster while performing operations and putting Americas Veterans at risk.

4. DESCRIPTION OF MARKET RESEARCH CONDUCTED AND RESULTS OR STATEMENT WHY IT WAS NOT CONDUCTED:

Market research was conducted to determine if there were any Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) concerns capable of providing the required supplies. A SDVOSB was identified and in accordance with Veterans Affairs Acquisition Regulation (VAAR) 819.7007 Sole source awards to service-disabled Veteran-owned small business concerns, the Contracting Officer has chosen to acquire the required supplies on a sole source bases from a SDVOSB concern.
