Reaching out with regards to subject solicitation SOW section found in page 6 of 37 of subject solicitation with the following "Installation Requirements" paragraph which reads:

"All work to be performed by licensed electricians as per NFPA Codes (NEC, etc.)."

Comparing the above to "Bid Content" section 9.d. which reads:

"Construction General Contractor's License – All Bidders shall submit a current Copy of Construction General Contractor's License from the SDVOSB Prime. A Construction General Contractor's License can be from any state that the SDVOSB Prime is registered and licensed as a Construction General Contractor."

We are a construction services company with high dollar value Federal / DoD Military Construction (MILCON) Program and Project management experience who do not hold a specific state general contractors license for Federal construction project management performance. However, we do hire all trade subcontractors that are licensed (we will provide the required subcontractor information accordingly) in the state of CA to perform specific task of Federal projects, e.g. electrical, mechanical, plumbing, demolition, concrete etc. As the verified prime SDVOSB construction management contractor we will be hiring a similarly situated small business electrician subcontractor who will be licensed to perform the required tasks of the project.

Will providing the license of the electrician subcontractor suffice the requirement for both the SOW "Installation Requirement" section and the "Bid Content" section 9.d.?
