This is a requirement for a specific commercial construction brick product. The requirement is for a brand name only, Acme-Ochs Brick & Stone Harvard Series. The St. Cloud VAHCS is a national historic site; therefore, it is required that all brick used on new facility buildings match the existing brick. Facilities Engineering has determined that the Acme-Ochs brand brick specified in this J&A meets the requirement.

Acme-Ochs has manufactured the brick for the site construction since its establishment in 1925.





Fire alarm control panels to be supplied programmed and tested by an Edwards System Technology equipment distributor.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other than Full and Open Competition: FAR 6.302-1(c). Application for brand name description. Only one responsible source and no other supplies or services will satisfy agency requirements.

5. Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority):

VAHCS Policy and National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) requirements in the National Fire Alarm Code (NFPA-72) require fire alarm systems to be Underwriters Laboratories (UL) listed. UL requires all fire alarm system components to be tested and listed for compatibility. The use of other brands of equipment for the main fire alarm control panel would not provide compatibility with the VAHCS's current building panels and communications system.

6. Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable:

Unlike some fire alarm equipment manufacturers, (Simplex, Johnson Controls or Honeywell) Edwards System Technology's fire alarm equipment is sold through distributors. Fire alarm equipment can be purchased by the electrical contractor competitively through any Edwards equipment distributor.

7. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:



The patient occupied buildings, as well as the entire facility, employs the Johnson Controls system to regulate the buildings Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) systems. The controls must be identical to the existing controls in every building to communicate with our centrally monitored Metasys System that our facility has in place.

Even more expense would be incurred to purchase this software and the associated training necessary to operate it.
