The Alaris PC unit, model 8015 is the controller that controls the Alaris Electronic infusion pump. The Alaris unit is the main controller and is programmed to tell the infusion pump what to do and how much medication to administer to patients. Alaris 8100 Infusion Pump module is compatible with both Alaris 8000 and Alaris 8015 PCU Infusion Pump units. The Alaris Pump Module, model 8100, is a pump used with the Alaris electronic infusion pump system and Alaris PC units. Electronic infusion pumps deliver controlled amounts of medications or other needed fluids to patients through intravenous (IV), intra-arterial (IV), epidural, and other acceptable routes of administration.

The current system is networked and WIFI connected to the existing OI&T VA network. No other vendor(s) system can integrate or interface with the systems software or hardware currently installed and in use at the VA SLC Health Care System. Currently all drug library updates and system updates are pushed through the network and the updates occur within the devices as they are booted up for utilization. No other vendor's devices will integrate or work with this Exclusive Alaris System. This system, above, also has special software known as (Guardrail software) this software system is linked to the modules software to help safeguard the patient when pump programming occurs to set medication dose limits.
