

STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES

(7/14/2017)

I. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this task order is to insure the Computer Tomography Scanner remains fully operational according to the manufacturer's specifications.

II. SCOPE OR MISSION:

This requirement is to provide a full range of service and maintenance for a Toshiba computer tomography system and a Medrad Stellant CT injection system, and associated peripheral equipment listed in Appendix A.

III. PLACE/TIME OF PERFORMANCE:

All work shall be performed on the equipment located at the Alexandria VA Health Care Facility, 2495 Shreveport Hwy 71, Pineville, Louisiana 71360, Monday thru Friday (except Federal Holidays) between the hours of 8:00AM and 5:00PM.

IV. BACKGROUND:

The equipment listed has been in operation for approximately one year except the Stellant CT Injector, which was installed in April of 2000. The Toshiba CT has an exposure count of 88,146 as of March 2, 2017. The Toshiba CT equipment was last serviced February 14, 2017. The Medrad Stellant Injector was last serviced in April of 2015.

V. PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES:

1. Technical support via telephone for the Biomedical Department and end user.
2. Preventative maintenance service according to the manufacturer's specifications.
3. Timely onsite response time.
4. Complete onsite repair service.
5. Uptime guarantee of 98%.
6. Glassware is to be covered.

VI. OPERATING CONSTRAINTS:

1. Personnel Security Requirements:

All contractors are to have current and approved security background investigations equivalent to investigations performed on federal employees.

2. Personnel Qualification:

The contractor must utilize properly certified personnel for all work associated with the covered equipment. The Government may request proof of certification at any time during the performance period of the associated contract.

3. Data:

Records and data shall be documented in deliverable reports (electronically). Any databases/code shall be delivered electronically and become the sole property of the United States Government. All deliverables become the sole property of the United States Government. The Government, for itself and such others as it deems appropriate, will have

unlimited rights under this contract to all information and materials developed under this contract and furnished to the Government and documentation thereof, reports and listings, and all other items pertaining to the work and services pursuant to this agreement including any copyright. Unlimited rights under this contract are rights to use, duplicate, or disclose data, and information, in whole or in part in any manner and for any purpose whatsoever without compensation to or approval from the provider. The Government will at all reasonable times have the right to inspect the work and will have access to and the right to make copies of the above-mentioned items. All digital files and data, and other products generated under this contract, shall become the property of the Government.

VII. CONFIDENTIALITY, SECURITY, AND PRIVACY:

In accordance with the Federal Acquisitions Regulations (FAR) clause 52.239-1, the Contractor shall be responsible for the following privacy and security safeguards:

1. The Contractor shall not publish or disclose in any manner, without the Contracting Officer's written consent, the details of any safeguards used by the Contractor under the resulting contract or otherwise provided by or for the government.
2. To the extent required to carry out a program of inspection to safeguard against threats and hazards to the security, integrity, and confidentiality of any non-public government data collected and stored by the Contractor, the Contractor shall afford the government access to the Contractor's facilities, installations, technical capabilities, operations, documentation, records, and databases.
