Questions and Answers Emergency Steel Awnings/Carports

Answers are in **RED**

Q1. We are requesting the sizes of the canopies for this solicitation. All we can locate are the side wall sizes. Do you have his information and/or drawings of the canopy sizes?

A1. The sizes are in the scope of work.

Site #1 requires site preparation, which includes but is not limited to leveling/grading and filling small holes, and placement of (48' x 40' + 5' (slight slope) x 2") recycled asphalt as parking base. This site is for the installation of the first steel awning/carport, which shall be placed to the West side of EM building (40' Length of Building x 48' Projection from Building' x 14' at eave Height- with minimum 13.8' clearance).

Site #2 requires site preparation, which includes but is not limited to leveling/grading and filling small holes and placement of $(150' \times 20' + 5' \text{ (slight slope)} \times 2'')$ recycled asphalt as parking base. This site is for the second steel awning/carport, which shall be placed to the West side of a warehouse-Building #78 $(100' \text{ Long } \times 20' \text{ Projection } \times 11' \text{ Height-with minimum of } 10' \text{ clearance})$.

Site #3 shall be placed behind Building 2 inside corner of fenced area and over already placed asphalt drive. Preparation of this site includes trimming a small to medium sized tree. This carport shall be (26' Long x 14' Projection x 8' Height-7' clearance).

- Q2. Are these canopies attached to the building? Do you have drawings?
- A2. The canopies are to be free standing and not attached to the buildings. There are no drawings for these.
- Q3. What are the approved work hours? Are we able to work outside of the work hours?
- A3. The approved work hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. we will allow the contractor to work from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. if they request it and it works within the activities of the VA.
