

SOURCES SOUGHT SYNOPSIS ONLY

This is a sources sought announcement ONLY and is NOT a request for proposals or quotes.

The purpose of this synopsis is to gain knowledge of potential qualified sources and their size classification (hubzone, 8(a), small, small disadvantage, service disabled veteran owned small business, or large business) relative to NACIS 541511 (Custom Computer Programming Services).

Responses to this synopsis will be used by the Government to make appropriate acquisition decisions. After review of the responses to this sources sought synopsis, a solicitation announcement may be published on FBO or GSA. Responses to this sources sought synopsis are not considered adequate responses to the solicitation announcement.

The Department of Veterans Affairs, Network Contracting Office 19, is seeking sources for a potential contract to provide an upgrade to current Vecna Software and new kiosk hardware for VetLink Check-In System in compliance with VA Veteran's Point of Service program.

Description of Work:

Contractor shall upgrade and migrate the existing Vecna VetLink system from current facility at 1055 Clermont St, Denver to the Replacement facility at 1700 Wheeling St, Aurora. All software license are Reused. The system must be able to work with the 11 Community-Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOCs) though out Eastern Colorado Healthcare System, the CBOCs shall not be replaced or upgraded, only the new VA Denver Medical Center. Vecna Technologies Inc. has submitted a Proprietary Statement stating they are "the only vendor able to deploy the VetLink software and hardware system for the VA Eastern Colorado Healthcare System. Vecna is also the only vendor who manufactures the required VetLink kiosk hardware".

General Requirements:

- Kiosk shall be a free-standing secure, touch-screen device, equipped a card scanner, card swipe, printer and proximity sensor.
- Compliant with the Americans with Disabilities (ADA).
- Act and Section 508 regulations for use by Veterans with disabilities.
- Kiosk shall operate as a thin client so no data is left on the kiosk.
- Each Kiosk shall have an approved surge protector.
- Each free-standing kiosk shall have the ability to be fixed to the floor so that the kiosk does not fall over.
- Kiosk shall be installed with tamper-resistant security screws.
- Warranty: minimum 5 years
- All features and application modules shall be continued from the existing system: Check-In, Patient Demographic update, Wayfinding and Benefit travel and queuing.
- Provide all server hardware and software that are required for the VetLink system.

Contractor shall submit:

- **A Capability Statement referencing the general requirements and description of work to performed.**
- **A Certified Distributor Letter from Vecna (Vecna Technologies Inc.).**
