2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF SUPPLIES OR SERVICES REQUIRED AND THE INTENDED USE:

The VA San Diego Healthcare System (VASDHS) is requesting services for the installation of the TempTrak Temperature Monitoring System. TempTrak offers 24/7 remote monitoring and runs on a wide range of systems supported by a broad range of hardware. The TempTrak system is fully BACnet compatible and integrates seamlessly with the Medical Center's Management System.

3. UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS THAT LIMIT AVAILABILITY TO ONLY ONE SOURCE, WITH THE REASON NO OTHER SUPPLIES OR SERVICES CAN BE USED:

In accordance with VAAR 819.7007, a contracting officer may award contracts to SDVOSB concerns on a sole source basis provided:

- The anticipated award price of the contract (including options) will not exceed \$5 million;
- The requirement is synopsized in accordance with FAR part 5;
- The SDVOSB concern has been determined to be a responsible contractor with respect to performance; and
- Award can be made at a fair and reasonable price.

The contracting officer's determination whether to make a sole source award is a business decision wholly within the discretion of the contracting officer. A determination that only one SDVOSB concern is available to meet the requirement is not required.

When conducting a SDVOSB sole source acquisition, the contracting officer shall ensure businesses are registered and verified as eligible in the VIP database prior to making an award.

Aldevra, LLC is a certified service disabled veteran owned small business in the www.vetbiz.gov database. Aldevra is an authorized dealer of Cooper-Atkins healthcare products and service. Aldevra does not have any derogatory reports on its Past Performance Information Retrieval System (PPIRS)/Contractor Performance Assessment Reports System (CPARS) account. An award will be made at a fair and reasonable by comparing the proposed price with prices found reasonable on previous purchases and through current market survey of prices.

The TempTrak system was delivered late to VA San Diego Healthcare System on August 23, 2017. Due to time constraints, it is in the government's best interest to make a sole source award to Aldevra, LLC in accordance with VAAR 819.7007.

4. DESCRIPTION OF MARKET RESEARCH CONDUCTED AND RESULTS OR STATEMENT WHY IT WAS NOT CONDUCTED:

A sources sought notice was posted for this requirement, and it was initially found that two SDVOSBs could provide the installation of the TempTrak system. The two SDVOSBs that responded to the sources sought notice were TrillaMed, LLC and Aldevra, LLC. After discussion with TrillaMed, LLC, it was found that Aldevra, LLC is an authorized dealer of Cooper-Atkins healthcare products and services, and TrillaMed, LLC could not provide a quote for the installation.

5. Contracting Officer's Certification: Based on the information above and in accordance with VAAR 819.7007, Aldevra provides the best value to the government at this time. Purchase is approved in accordance with FAR 13.106-1(b). I certify that the foregoing justification is accurate and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief.
