

Salient/Functional/Performance Characteristics

Sterile Processing Storage Space Saver Rack System

1. Quad adjust racks so you could add in racks without dismantling the entire shelving unit.
2. V-grooved tracks which collect less debris and have been approved for use by our hospital Infection Control.
3. Each shelf needs to be 24 inches deep to accommodate the size of our instrument trays. The width of the racks will vary depending on where they are located.
4. Track system must have a crank/mechanical assist wheel on the outside of each rack so that employees are not injured trying to push and pull the racks themselves.
5. End racks in each section need to be stationary and on the long wall there will also need to be a stationary rack in the middle.
6. Racks need to have aisles as indicated on the layout charts approximately 4 ½' so that multiple staff can pull surgical cases at the same time.
