

CURRENT BIDDER QUESTIONS RECEIVED: 8-22-17

- 1). Please be advised that the following drawings for the above project were not included in Addenda #2 ---NLR Work EWT-1 and RPZ-1. LR Work - TR-1 and TR-2. Additionally, we are missing document SP-1 (specification corrections and additions).
- 2). On drawing ASD-1BR there are three (3) keyed notes #01, #02 and #03. On drawing WA-1E there are several keyed notes #5 and on WA-3C there are several keyed notes #4. Can you furnish a clarifications on Keyed Notes #04 and #05?
- 3). Would it be acceptable to use braided flex lines on the Lavatory Mixing valve installation in lieu of the tubing shown on detail in Sheet [ASD-1BR]?
- 4). It is our understanding that the access panel for Shower Valve installation detailed as (NAP/ASV) on sheet [ASD-1BR] will need to be modified. An opening for the control stem will have to be added in the new panel. Is this correct?

- 1). NLR DRAWINGS EWT-1, RPZ-1, TR-1 AND TR-2 HAVE BEEN ADDED TO THE FEDBIZ PROJECT SITE. ALSO REFERENCE OTHER DRAWINGS THAT HAVE BEEN ADDED. DOCUMENT SP-1 IS CURRENTLY ON THE SITE AND IS LISTED AS DOC VA256-17-B-0485- A00003006.
- 2). KEYED NOTES ON THE WA DRAWINGS, REFER TO THE KEYED NOTES ON THE APPLICABLE ASD DRAWINGS. ON THE WA DRAWINGS, THERE IS A NOTE IN THE WORK AREA NOTES (FIRST LINE) TO REFER TO THE ASD DRAWING FOR THE KEYED NOTES DESCRIPTION ON THE WA DRAWING.
- 3). FLEXIBLE BRAIDED OR PLASTIC TUBING IS NOT PERMITTED BY THE VA STANDARDS FOR PIPING TO FIXTURES.
- 4). NAP/ASD (WORDING IS CIRCLED), REFERS TO LOCATIONS WHERE SHOWER VALVE IS REPLACED FROM THE FRONT (USER) SIDE OF THE VALVE. IN THOSE LOCATIONS IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT A COVER PLATE WILL BE REQUIRED, IN ADDITION TO THE SHOWER VALVE COVER . REFERENCE THE SPECIFICATIONS, AND ALSO NOTE DETAIL SHOWN ON DWG. ASD-4B, FOR DETAIL AT A TUB/SHOWER LOCATION. OTHER FRONT SIDE REPLACEMENT LOCATIONS ARE SIMILAR. THE DRAWINGS SHOW WHERE IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT SHOWERS REQUIRE FRONT OR (USER SIDE) REPLACEMENT OF THE SHOWER VALVE.
