The new work is a logical follow-on to an original Federal Supply Schedule order provided that the original order was placed in accordance with the applicable Federal Supply Schedule ordering procedures. The original order must not have been previously issued under sole source or limited source procedures.
This procurement is for a follow-on contract for the acquisition of laboratory testing services for the
Phoenix VA Health Care System. The services required are for specialized clinical and anatomic
pathology diagnostic testing services. The services are required on an as-needed basis for laboratory testing protocols not performed by the in-house laboratory.
An urgent and compelling need exists, and following the ordering procedures would result in unacceptable delays.
The Phoenix VA Health Care System requires laboratory results on a as-needed basis and same day

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service for its Veteran patients. A lapse in services will have a serious impact on patient health care and safety. The needed laboratory results must be entered in the Veterans Administration's patient record system. To add another contractor's system to interface with the Veteran Administration Patient's record system will take approximately six to eight months. The costs are unknown and further market

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research will need to be performed to determine the actual costs and timeframe. The PVAHCS requires laboratory testing services on the first day of the next fiscal year October 1, 2017. VISN 22 will be taking over all reference laboratory service contracts in the new fiscal year.
