This order is for the annual testing requirement for the Southeast Louisiana VA Healthcare System for Tb Testing via the T-Spot Interferon Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) methodology proprietary to Oxford Immunotec. The requirement is for approximately 160 tests per month (1920 est. annual.)

4. Authority:
