3. Description of Supplies or Services:

The estimated value of the proposed action is \$209,809.78

This overarching Scope Of Work includes the programming, cabling, installation, and equipment for to add eleven (11) new IP cameras and replace sixty six (66) cameras that will be added to the existing ONSSI Ocularis IS video management system. Three (3) new 12 TB video servers will be added to accommodate new cameras. The system interfaces with the existing iStar EX panel in the police command center and the existing SimplexGrinnell 4100_ES fire alarm system.

GENERAL DELIVERABLES:

The license servers will be located in Bldg#1 room 131. 66 Cameras will be replaced in Bldg. 21 DOM and Bldg. 20 throughout. Cameras will be located on the exterior of of the following locations: 4 cameras Bldg 4, 6 cameras Bldg 30, and 1 camera Bldg 48 NOTE: Current System controls alarms/cameras under one system – the software required to run the system is proprietary to TYCO-SimplexGrinnell.
