

JUSTIFICATION FOR SINGLE SOURCE AWARDS IAW FAR 13.106-1
(OVER MICRO-PURCHASE THRESHOLD(\$3K) BUT NOT EXCEEDING THE SAT (\$150K))

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF SUPPLIES OR SERVICES REQUIRED AND THE INTENDED USE:

The VA Puget Sound Health Care System is in need of a new CardioQuip Modular Cooler-Heater as the current heater/cooler is out of life since March 2016. The VA requires a unit does not have a compressor that chills water but does have a cooling fan that blows air downward below the machine. History of patients acquiring NTM infections from a heater-cooler that has a compressor that blows air upward into the room.

3. UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS THAT LIMIT AVAILABILITY TO ONLY ONE SOURCE, WITH THE REASON NO OTHER SUPPLIES OR SERVICES CAN BE USED:

SALIENT CHARACTERISTICS:

A cooler-heater to supply temperature-controlled water to heat exchange devices (e.g.; Cardiopulmonary Bypass Heat Exchangers) to help control a patient's temperature during extracorporeal circulatory support and/or thermal regulation procedures. The cooling fan on the cooler-heater is to be minimal and to blow downward below the unit. Water connections should be quick-connect, no-spill with two-way shutoff fittings. Maximum flow rate (high/low) should be 20 / 14 LPM (5.3 / 3.7 GPM). Maximum pressure should be 83 kPa / 12 psi (closed loop). Temperature control (°C) should range from 0.0 - 42.0, Accuracy ±0.5. The alarm sound pressure range (dB) should be 41 – 58.

4. DESCRIPTION OF MARKET RESEARCH CONDUCTED AND RESULTS OR STATEMENT WHY IT WAS NOT CONDUCTED:

RFI went out set aside for SDVOSB/VOSBs and Small Businesses. No response received from SDVOSB/VOSBs and 1 response received from Small Businesses.
