HIGLINT STATdx Point of Care Radiology Diagnostic Clinical Decision Support Product/Subscription

1. Contracting Activity:

Department of Veterans Affairs, Veterans Health Administration (VHA), Program Contracting Activity Central (PCAC), 6150 Oak Tree Blvd, Suite 300, Independence, OH 44131. Office of Informatics and Information Governance (OIIG), VA Library Network Office, offer this Justification for Other Than Full and Open competition. Purchase Request Number is 776-17-4-8152-0321.

2. Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:

This request is for a continuation of an existing subscription to the STATdx Point of Care Radiology Diagnostic Clinical Decision Support Product for the VHA Library Network Office. The proposed action is for a new standalone, firm-fixed price contract (Base plus four (4) option years).

This procurement is being conducted in accordance with FAR 13.5 Simplified Procedures for Certain Commercial Items and specifically FAR 13.501 Special Documentation Requirements, where acquisitions conducted under Simplified Acquisition Procedures are exempt from the requirements of FAR Part 6, but still require a justification using the format of FAR 6.303-2

3. Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:

STATdx, published by Elsevier, is an existing, commercial, off-the-shelf, web-based, point of care radiology diagnostic clinical decision support product currently utilized by clinicians throughout the VA which is designed to provide information at the patient's bedside or point of care and includes a mechanism to support and provide clinical radiology decision support knowledge at the point-of-care. STATdx includes over 200,000 searchable images that can be easily navigated by caregivers. 4,300 diagnoses written by radiology experts are accessible with the program. Additionally, the subscription includes the ability to use RAD search to search alternating information online in a 508-compliant package.

The estimated total value of the acquisition is \$1,415,000.00, for the five (5) year life of the contract. A year-by-year estimated cost breakdown is as follows:

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other than Full and Open Competition:

FAR 13.5 Simplified Procedures for Certain Commercial Items: The authority for applying the Simplified Procedures for Commercial Items of FAR 13.5 is 41 U.S.C. 1901 and is implemented by for restricting competition on this procurement via FAR 13.106-1(b)(2).

5. Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority):

STATdx is a point-of-care online diagnostic decision support system and online diagnostic decision support solution that increases accuracy and confidence in diagnosing complex imaging cases. Primary users of STATdx are radiologists and other caregivers; however, its use is also prevalent in academic settings as well. STATdx has distinct features and competencies not found in other radiology clinical decision support systems. The database for this product is extensive and has been used throughout the VHA in similar formats by caregivers since 2013. STATdx unique features and competencies include:

- 200,000 high-quality, expert selected and annotated image examples, including x-ray CT, MR and ultrasound images
- More than 1,300 differential diagnosis modules based on anatomy, imaging patterns clinical presentation or modality-specific findings
- Over 4,000 common and complex diagnoses
- STATDX Global Search, an exclusive feature, allows non English speakers to search STATdx in 49 different languages
- Over 20,000 supporting individual patient cases, each of which includes demographics, history, case description, and the author/contributor
- Annotations from a renowned expert in that field with numerous labeled images
- 195 concise, detailed radiological procedures with step-by-step guidelines, pre-, intra-, and post procedure tips
- Image search tool to quickly browse through the 200,000 high quality annotated images

Further, Elsevier also meets the VA's needs by providing enterprise-wide access to their content with no geographic or concurrent user limitations. This product is 508 compliant per government needs.

Elsevier is the only firm capable of providing the supplies and services described in Section III above without the Veteran's Health Administration experiencing substantial duplication of cost that could not be expected to be recovered through competition

6. Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable:

A special notice of intent to sole source (VA701-17-N-0137) was posted to FBO.gov on 05/04/2017 with responses due by 05/18/2017 at 10:00 AM. No responses were received.

7. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:

The Government will use price analysis to verify that the overall price offered is fair and reasonable. This will include, but is not limited to a comparison of the proposed price to historical prices paid for the same or similar items; and a comparison of the proposed price to the Independent Government Cost Estimate (IGCE). The Contracting Officer may need to conduct additional analysis before making a fair and reasonable price determination

8. Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted:

In accordance with FAR Part 10, market research has been conducted for this acquisition. The following techniques were used:

A search was conducted on the GSA e-Library under Schedule 76 – Publication Media/SIN 760-2 – Periodicals, Subscriptions Services. There are a total of 25 vendors, a total of one (1) SDVOSB vendors, and two (2) VOSB vendors. A review of these vendor's price lists found the Elsevier subscription package offered by the vendor did not meet the Government's requirements.

A search was conducted on www.vetbiz.gov to attempt to find veteran businesses (SDVOSB and VOSB) utilizing NAICS code 519130. Upon review of these vendors zero (0) can offer a STATdx subscription.

A search was conducted via http://dsbs.sba.gov/dsbs/search/dsp_dsbs.cfm located within the Small Business Association's (SBA) website utilizing NAICS code 519130. The search came back with zero (0) results.

The Senior National Accounts Manager of Elsevier was contacted by Email and asked if they would allow any resellers. Elsevier stated that no resellers could be used.

9. Any Other Facts Supporting the Use of Other than Full and Open Competition:

As stated in Section 8 of this J&A, a Notice of Intent to Sole Source was published to FBO.gov and no responses were received. Additionally, an email was sent to the Government point of contact for Elsevier, which confirmed that no verified SDVOSB or VOSB could supply this product. Further market research confirmed this. The content of the STATdx Point of Care Radiology Diagnostic Clinical Decision Support Product contains numerous features that are not contained in any other product on the marketplace.

10. Listing of Sources that Expressed, in Writing, an Interest in the Acquisition:
