3. Description of Supplies or Services:

The requirement is to provide 31 ceiling mounted patient handling systems at James Haley Veterans Hospital. The estimated value of the proposed action is at a total cost of \$319,852.73. This requirement requires that a complete ceiling lift program be tailored to the specific needs of a new unit of the hospital. This will allow the SCI Department to facilitate safe transfer of non-ambulatory patients with the use of appropriate equipment to greatly reduces staff's musculoskeletal strain and the risk of injury. The estimated delivery date is November 30, 2017.

Fedco is a Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business, certified by the CVE of the Department of Veterans Affairs and SAM Registered. This procurement authority, and its subsequent implementation, is a logical extension of VA's mission to care for our Nation's Veterans.

(6) DESCRIBE THE MARKET RESEARCH CONDUCTED AMONG SCHEDULE HOLDERS AND THE RESULTS OR A STATEMENT OF THE REASON MARKET RESEARCH WAS NOT CONDUCTED:

Market Research was conducted on GSA Advantage and found FEDCO (SDVOSB) as an authorized distributor. The Veterans' Benefit Act of 2003 exception to the VA Rule of Two has authority that allows the VA to award to eligible veterans without competition and to be use entirely at their discretion.

(7) ANY OTHER FACTS SUPPORTING THE JUSTIFICATION: Fedco is familiar with the James Haley VA facility and have provided and installed these lifts previously. These same lifts give the nursing staff continuity of care by being already trained on the exact equipment.
