

ATTACHMENT E – QUESTIONS/ANSWERS

Questions:

1. Are you willing to consider technologies other than optically stimulated luminescence that provide the same or superior efficacy?
2. On Attachment B, also known as the price sheet, what figure do you seek in the "total" column? Is it:
 - a. The estimated quantity of badges per wear period x the number of wear periods per year ("quantity" column) x unit price, OR
 - b. The number of wear periods per year ("Quantity" column) x unit price, OR
 - c. Another array of factors. If "C", please detail those factors.
3. On page 26 of the same document referenced in bullet #2, in the "GRAND TOTAL" cell, are you seeking an estimated spend for the ENTIRE 5-year contract period? If not, please detail what you desire.
4. Attachment A states "The combined synopsis solicitation is 100% Set-Aside for applicable Service Disabled Veterans Owned Small Businesses". We, SDV Enterprise, qualify in this category. However, we are a reseller, not a dosimetry processor. There are no dosimetry PROCESSORS in the United States which qualify as a Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business. The dosimetry processor we represent meets/exceeds all your qualifications set forth in the various RFQ documents. Based on this are you willing to accept our submission as a Service Disabled Veteran Owned Business on behalf of a NVLAP-accredited dosimetry processor?

Answers:

1. You can submit a bid for like items if you feel it meets the salient characteristics on Attachment C. Be sure to provide clear, detail literature that will explain how the like items will meet the needs of the service.
2. The Attachment B document has been revised and amended on FBO. Total columns have been added to allow you to provide the total amount for each year. The figures we seek is:

Unit price per monthly cost for the estimated quantities provided in the line item x 12 months = total cost

For example, #1: As stated, estimated quantity of 300 badges per month x Unit price of (\$) amount x 12 months = (\$) amount of dollars.

Then add all the totals within that base year to give the overall total. Once you've provided totals for each year, you then submit the Grand Total (base plus 4 option years).

3. Please see answer #2.
4. Yes, the solicitation is intended for any SDVOSB distributor to submit a bid.
