1) During the site visit held on December 14th, it was said that buildings that had been deemed unsafe for entry (Keeler-Webb Assoc. Survey dated 6/2/16) would not have any asbestos removed and would be demolished as is and hauled to the landfill. Specifications section 02 82 13.41-1 Extent of Work states that all asbestos abatement must be completed prior to demolition of buildings.

2) If the buildings are being demolished with ACM in place, how would the VA like the abatement contractors to price oversight during demolition and loading of asbestos contaminated debris?
