If it is, the contractor is to remove and dispose of as hazardous waste. Contractor to provide for 50 cubic yards of remediation in their base bid with a per yard unit price for remediation in excess of 50 CY. This requirement is for each individual location at bldgs. 7-10-11-18.
