1. Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:

This is a justification for other than full and open competition being executed IAW the authority of VAAR 819-7007 Sole Source Awards to a Verified Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business. This action will provide a short-term contract for the delivery of PHMB Antimicrobial Wound Matrix products (PurPly) to the Richmond VA Medical Center as their stock of this product is nearly depleted.

2. Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:

PurPly is currently used at the Richmond VAMC to treat biofilms (superficial clinically colonized wound) on ulcers of the body. The product is used for the purpose of preparing the ulceration properly with regards to controlling bacterial critical colonization prior to the application of bioengineered tissues, human amniotic membranes and even autografts to prevent enzymatic degradation of these tissues resulting in wasteful spending of wounds not properly prepared to receive these expensive allogeneic products. To minimize the current gap in service, market research was limited to procurement history which revealed that historically ERA Health has been the only CVE Verified SDVOSB to provide an offer on this requirement. During the performance of this contract, this office will attempt a recompete of a long term solution via GPE to seek competition to the maximum extent practicable based on the results of additional market research.

6. <u>Determination by the CO that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:</u>

The Contracting Officer anticipates that Fair and Reasonable pricing shall be received after a review of Historical Pricing offered by ERA Health.

7. <u>Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted:</u>

Market Research was limited to procurement history which revealed that ERA Health has successfully performed these contracts in the past. A query into the VIP Database was executed to validate that ERA Health LLC dba Veterans Health was currently listed as a CVE Verified SDVOSB

Two previous contracts were placed with ERA Health LLC dba Veterans Health for the PurPly AM Wound Matrix product in the last twelve (12) months:

8. Any Other Facts Supporting the Use of Other than Full and Open Competition:

The PurPly AM Wound Matrix product is required for patient care at the Richmond VAMC. Due to the nature of the product and time constraints, the proposed Bridge Contract to ERA Health LLC dba Veterans Health fulfills an immediate and continued need for the Government.
