1. Requirements:

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) is seeking to acquire a quantity of one (1) Xerox FreeFlow Variable Information (VI) eCompose software license and one (1) maintenance agreement in support for the Legacy Document Repository (LDR) formally known as Virtual Veterans Affairs (Virtual VA) System. LDR uses the Xerox FreeFlow eCompose to extract page information to process high-volume documents from Batch Feed Imports (BFIs) feeds. Employing templates of various sorts and PostScript code encapsulated in a language known as VIPP (Variable Intelligent PostScript Printware). FreeFlow produces pdf-format documents and associated metadata from ASCII files containing the data needed to make each of the letters or documents required. At a high-level, FreeFlow merges the design template and variable data file to the "printer" to produce electronic documents in PDF format. Xerox FreeFlow VI eCompose, brand name or equivalent software allows the LDR user to generate Adobe PDF documents from VIPP based (VI) variable data applications. Xerox FreeFlow VI eCompose software seamlessly integrates Xerox VIPP with the Adobe PDF engine. This version is required for a "Production" environment whereby multiple users could submit jobs to or benefit from the PDF output. The "Use" cases depicting if the Multi-User or "production" version of the product is appropriate are:

- the PDF output will be made available over the web to multiple individuals
- the PDF output will be archived for later use
- the PDF output will be emailed
- or the PDF output will be used to drive non-VIPP enabled print engines.

The period of performance for this action shall be for 12 months with one 12 month option period.
