2. Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:

The Hampton VA Medical Center requires additional Brand name Physio-Control LifePak Defibrillators, monitors, and associated accessories.

FAR13.5 Simplified Procedures for Certain Commercial Items: This procurement is for Lifepak Defibrillators and associated accessories in accordance with FAR 13.5 Simplified Procedures for Certain Commercial Items and specifically FAR 13.501 Special Documentation Requirements, where acquisitions conducted under Simplified Acquisition Procedures are exempt from the requirements of FAR Part 6, but still require a justification using the format of FAR 6.303-1.

3. Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:

The Hampton VA Medical Center requires additional Physio-Control LifePak Defibrillators, monitors, associated accessories, and replacements systems for several units that are no longer serviceable to upgrade and expand the existing Physio-Control resuscitation portfolio. Recently constructed facilities and additions have necessitated the expansion. The requirement includes LifePak 15 V4 (7), LifePak 15 (7), LifePak 1000 (8), and accessory items such as batteries, carrying cases, wall units, and hard paddles.

FAR13.5 Simplified Procedures for Certain Commercial Items: The authority for applying the Simplified Procedures for Commercial Items of FAR 13.5 is 41 U.S.C. 1901 and is implemented by for restricting competition on this procurement via FAR 13.106-1(b)(2).

5. <u>Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires</u> the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority):

The Hampton VA Medical Center and the various Communit, Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOCS) are standardized with the Physio-Control Defibrillators and AEDS. The existing inventory includes LifePak 15 V2 (2), LifePak ACLS (4), Lifepak 15 (20), LifePak 1000 (33) and associated accessories. VA Medical staff must be intimately familiar with this life saving equipment, and standardization is paramount for clinicians and other staff members to be able to react im nediately to perform life saving techniques. Selection of multiple platforms from different manufacturers is not compatible for use of this high stress life saving equipment. Therefore, purchasing an alternate resuscitation systems would require replacing the existing system.

In addition, the VA Medical Healthcare Staff would have to trained on how to operate the new equipment, and the Bio-Medicine technicans would have to trained on use, maintenance, and care. Installation of the resuscitation systems and training would not only be an additional cost, it would also take several weeks to accomplish. Physio-Control is the only brand capable of meeting the need without the Hampton VA Medical Center experiencing substantial duplication of cost and unacceptable delays.

6. <u>Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable:</u>

Exhaustive market research was conducted to identify all possible sources to whom solicitations could be issued. The following are the market research sources that were utilized to discover potential sources: Supplies & Services (Mandatory IAW FAR 8 002), Other Mandatory Sources (FAR 8.003), Mandatory Sources for VA (Ref. 38 U.S.C. 8127 and 8128), Non-Mandatory Sources by VA (808.004-70), and Other Sources (FAR 8.004).

7. <u>Determination by the CO that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:</u>

Implementing a new resuscitation program from a different manufacturer would result in duplication of costs to replace the existing equipment and retraining the staff. Purchasing the Physio-Control brand represents the best value and overall lowest cost alternative. Current Market research supports pricing which is within the previous awarded value.

8. <u>Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted:</u>

Market research conducted shows Physio-Control, Inc. as the original equipment manufacturer (OEM). Per the OEM, Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small B usinesses (SDVOSB) 1 Source

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Solutions, LLC. and The Janz Corporation are Physio-Control, Inc. authorized resellers. Market research on GSA Advantage shows some items are available via GSA Advantage via three (3) small business vendors AED Brands, LLC. CPR Savers & First Aid Supply, LLC., Zoetek Medical Sales & Service, Inc. and two (2) large business vendors Physio-Control, Inc. and Allied 100, LLC.
