6. Rational/explanation to support cited authority:

The VA Western New York Healthcare System in Buffalo presently uses ten (10) Philips V60 ventilators. In order to properly replace the last remaining end-of-life BiPAP versions, the facility requires six (6) additional Philips Medical V60 ventilators in order to standardize the type/model BiPAP ventilator used for non-critical care situations.
