REVIT/CAD FILE RELEASE AGREEMENT

OWNERSHIP & USE OF REVIT & CAD FILES:

The electronic files provided by the Architect to -----, hereafter referred to as the recipient, are intended solely to be used for the preparation of AutoCAD and Revit drawings/models for Building 1A Seismic corrections at VA Sierra Nevada Health Care Systems, (RBB Project # 1013700).

The electronic files are provided for the purpose of: producing Building Information Modeling

These files are Autodesk Revit 2011 & ADT 2008 .RVT & .DWG format respectively compatible with several CAD software packages operating on an IBM-Compatible PC under Windows XP, 7 & higher. The Architect makes no warranty as to the compatibility of these files beyond the specified release of the above-stated format. The Architect is not responsible for uses of data outside of or beyond the scope of the Agreement.

Both parties hereby acknowledge mutually non-exclusive Ownership of the electronic files and each party may use, alter, modify, or delete the files without consequence to the other party.

The recipient shall be permitted to retain copies of the drawings and specifications prepared in Revit & CAD for its own information and use in this project. Due to the potential that the information set forth on the computer disks and/or magnetic tapes can be modified by the recipient, unintentionally or otherwise, the Architect reserves the right to remove all indicia of its Ownership and/or involvement from each display.

RIGHT / ABILITY TO ALTER CAD FILES

Any use or re-use of the material by the recipient or others, without written verification by the Architect or CAD adaptation of it for other than the specific purpose intended, will be at the recipient's sole risk and without liability or legal exposure to the Architect or his consultants. Furthermore, the recipient will, to the fullest extent permitted by law, indemnify and hold the Architect or his consultants harmless from any and all claims, suits, liability, demands or costs arising out of or resulting there from.

ACCEPTANCE OF ELECTRONIC CAD DATA

The electronic files provided by Architect to the recipient may not exactly match the plans approved by the regulatory agencies having jurisdiction and those which are in the Contract Set of documents.

It is the recipient's sole responsibility to compare the electronic files with the Contract Documents to ensure accuracy. If there is a discrepancy between the Contract Set and the electronic files, the Contract Set shall take precedence.

Because data stored on electronic media can deteriorate undetected or be modified without the Architect's knowledge, the recipient agrees not to hold Architect or his consultants liable for the completeness or correctness of the electronic data after delivery of the electronic files.
