

ITEM NUMBER	DESCRIPTION OF SUPPLIES/SERVICES
1	Fee for delivery of durable medical equipment (DME) from VA/contractor warehouse to the beneficiary's address. This fee shall include set-up, and training on the care and usage of the equipment and any time needed to prepare the equipment for delivery. Jobsites/cases including possible multiple flights of stairs and multiple clinicians must be accounted in the pricing. The unit of measure (UNOM) is each trip.
2	Fee for delivery - drop off ONLY. No set up and training. The unit of measure (UNOM) is each trip
3	Fee for pickup of durable medical equipment (DME). This fee includes inspection, and cleaning prior to storage at contractor's facility or in the appropriate VA facility as instructed by VA authorized personnel. Jobsites/cases including possible multiple flights of stairs and multiple technicians must be accounted in the pricing. the unit of measure (UNOM) is per each trip
4	Fee for pick up of durable medical equipment (DME) for immediate disposal without the possibility of re-issuance. The unit of measure (UNOM) is per each trip.
5	The contractor shall be reimbursed for mileage for deliveries and pickups made. The mileage shall be calculated using the distances provided by MapQuest or equivalent software that the following web-site: www.mapquest.com . The reimbursement rate will be the GSA contract rate for Privately Owned Vehicle Mileage-- www.gsa.gov . When multiple Jobs routes are consolidated Mapquest routes sheets with waypoints must be submitted for mileage reimbursements.
6	Emergency maintenance of DME, including emergency calls, after hours, and during evenings 5:01 pm - 7:59 am, and weekends. Shall be billed at 15 min intervals.
7	Routine repairs completed upon request. Cost is established for service call to fix minor repairs or provide quote along with parts needing to be ordered. Shall be billed at 15 min intervals.
8	Set up and delivery of Scooter/Power Operated Vehicle (POV) as defined by Medicare guidelines
9	Set up and delivery of Power Wheelchair Group 2 with Captains Seat as defined Medicare guidelines
10	Set up and delivery of Power Wheelchair Group 2 with Rehab Seat as defined Medicare guidelines

11	Set up and delivery of Power Wheelchair Group 3 as defined Medicare guidelines
12	Set up and delivery of Power Wheelchair Group 4 as defined Medicare guidelines
13	Set up and delivery of Power Wheelchair Group 5 as defined Medicare guidelines
14	The contractor shall be reimbursed for repair parts at a cost 10% markup when requested by the Prosthetics & Sensory Aids service. The contractor shall invoice for these parts as a separate item; and provide a copy to the VA.
