- The magnitude of construction is between \$25,000.00 and \$100,000.00 as prescribed in VAAR Part 836.204.
- Bid Evaluation criteria

The low bidder shall be the bidder that – complies with all aspects of the solicitation and is otherwise eligible for award; i.e. submitted a responsive bid IAW FAR 14.301 and is determined to be responsible IAW FAR 9.104

- For that reason, carefully follow “Instructions, Conditions, and Notices to Offerors” in the solicitation **Standard Form 1442 (Solicitation, Offer and Award– Construction, Alteration, or Repair)** shall be used for submitting cost offers (i.e ALL amendments must be acknowledged, proposal signed)
- Bids must be submitted using OF-17 Offer Label. See VAAR 852.214-70 CAUTION TO BIDDERS-BID ENVELOPES
- Please do not laminate or otherwise bind the offer because it has to be scanned for the contract file.
- Failure to furnish the required bid guarantee in the proper form and amount, by the time set for opening of bids, will require rejection of the bid in all cases except those listed in FAR 28.101-4, and may be cause for rejection even then.
- This is a total Service Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business 100% Set-Aside Competitive Procurement pursuant to Public Law 109-461 (38 USC 8127).

The SDVOSB is required to perform a minimum of 15% of the construction work on the project with its own labor force or the labor force of other SDVOSB subcontractors. The SDVOSB must be small under the relevant NAICS code.

All offerors must be listed as “verified” in the VIP database, available in VETBIZ at <http://www.vip.vetbiz.gov> and VETS-100, must also be registered in System for Award Management SAM data base under NAICS 236220 along with complete online Reps and Certs <https://www.sam.gov> in order to submit offers and be eligible for award.

Engineering presentation

- Contractor layout area will be shown to the winning bidder at the pre performance conference.
