## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The Veterans Health Administration (VHA) has purchased a license for DSS Clinical Information System (CIS)-DataBridge, a Veterans Health Information Systems and Technology Architecture (VistA)-integrated, graphical user interface designed to manage complex clinical information generated on patients who are admitted to the OR and/or the ICU. DataBridge was specifically developed to filter information between VistA/CPRS and the ARK/CIS, allowing the ARK/CIS to automate the collection, integration, and communication of specific medical data with the goal of improving performance and patient outcomes.

VISN 12 requires the CIS DataBridge perpetual licenses for seven hospitals for software subscription maintenance and support which includes 24x7 coverage for bug fixes, minor release upgrades, and telephone support. These licenses are for an existing CIS system and therefore the procurement must be brand-name only. Period of performance shall be for a base plus four option years.

In performance of this effort, the contractor shall not perform a function that requires access to a VA system or VA sensitive information (e.g., system administrator privileged access to a VA system, or contractor systems or processes that utilize VA sensitive information). Additionally, the contractor shall not connect one or more contractor-owned IT devices to a VA internal trusted network. Finally, this acquisition does not involve the storage, generating, transmitting, or exchanging of VA sensitive information.
