This is a new requirement that will be pursued as a Fixed Firm Price contract for Brand Name Only, sole source procurement on the open market to a Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB).

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3. Unique characteristics that limit availability to only one source, with the reason no other supplies or services can be used:

The Carl Zeiss Meditec AG OS Forum Archive and Viewer package has the ability to connect all current ophthalmic devices located in the Eye Clinic at the William S. Middleton Memorial Veterans Hospital located in Madison, WI. This system will be able to work with facility's current DICOM-compatible devices and then transfer images into the VISTA imaging platform. It allows for storage of ophthalmic images, raw data, and display and manipulation of that raw data. This product is made from Carl Zeiss Meditec AG which also produces the Humphrey Field Analyzers (HFA) that the facility owns. There is a pressing need to purchase this Forum package as soon as possible to link the machines in the clinic and thus alleviating any possible potential for missing progression which is a patient safety issue. These types of studies are preformed daily.

4. Description of market research conducted and results or statement why it was not conducted:

In addition to an unsuccessful VIP VetBiz search, the Contracting Officer (CO) contacted the manufacturer to determine if it uses any Veteran-Owned Small Businesses (VOSBs) or Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Businesses (SDVOSBs) to distribute its products. The manufacture responded with one SDVOSB. The CO also conducted a search on FPDS and found the same equipment purchased by a CO in NCO-6. The NCO-6 purchase was to the same single SDVOSB identified by the manufacturer. Past procurements and correspondence with the manufacturer have also shown the equipment to be available through another Carl Zeiss Meditec AG distributor which is a Small Business.

Although this requirement may be set-aside for Small Businesses, it is determined this procurement will be fulfilled via open market sole source to Corps Biologics, LLC, (DUNS: 079721871) utilizing the Veterans First Contracting Program IAW Public Law (PL) 109-461 which requires the Veterans Affairs (VA) to increase contracting and subcontracting opportunities for Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Businesses and Veteran-Owned Small Businesses.
