- 2. Description of Action:** The Fayetteville VAMC is in need of (1) 3S Hemi Implant System & (1) Tiger Headless Cannulated Screw System for their Podiatry Services Department at the Wilmington Health Care Center.

- 3. Description of Supplies or Services:** This requirement is for a brand name request to supply the Fayetteville VAMC with a “Tiger Headless Cannulated Screw System” and a “3S Hemi Implant System”. The two systems will be used to assist the physicians in the Podiatry Service at Wilmington Health Care Center. The Tiger Headless Cannulated Screw System is a Tiger stripe flute intended to channel out bone particulate, increase implant-to-bone surface area for better osteointegration capabilities, and disperse insertion stress. It provides multiple cutting edges and augers to provide tremendous bite, cutting power, and ease of insertion in dense cortical bone. The 3S Hemi Implant System has a low profile anatomical head shape to allow for natural articulation and to provide the option of preserving host bone. It also provides for a simple surgical technique for reduced OR time. These brand-name items are used in Fayetteville’s main facility and will be purchased by the Podiatry department for the purposes of continuity of care and consistency in instrumentation. Market research shows that the items in need are proprietary to Trilliant Surgical LTD (Small Business; DUNS: 828829072).

The estimated value of the proposed action is \$ 60,500.02

4. Authority:


