Question 1: Page 5 of 11, Bullet 6 implies the bidder must be an "Authorized Distributor" (of plumbing supplies). As a Reseller of plumbing parts and supplies buying from Authorized Distributors throughout the country do we meet this requirement?

Answer 1: Please provide proof your firm is an authorized reseller/distributor of the requirement.

Question 2: Does the VA recognize the most current List of Designated Countries associated with the Buy American Act, FAR 52.225-1, Buy American-Supplies (MAY 2014), and FAR 52.225-5, Trade Agreements (OCT 2016)?

Answer 2: Yes

Question 3: Regarding the Price Cost Schedule and the requirement that the Proposal shall include (1) unit pricing for each item and (2) identify special pricing for bulk procurements:
a. For the Price Cost Schedule as written, are we to identify unit pricing per item for each year one thru five?

Answer: Yes
b. In addition to submitting the required Price Cost Schedule, can we submit a separate price sheet to show, using the estimated usage data per item shown, to reflect special pricing/price breaks for bulk procurements to clearly meet the second portion of the pricing requirement? If not, how would you like this information presented in the proposal?

Question 4: Regarding the Unit of Measurement contained in the Price Cost Schedule, for clarity is the Estimated Usage shown for each item expressed as a quantity or a unit of measurement. In the example below, is Estimated Usage a quantity of 25-10 Linear Feet pieces to equal 250 Feet or 10 Linear Feet times a quantity of 250 each to equal 2500 Linear Feet? This question also applies to the use of 'PK', 'C', and 'FT' Units of Measure in the Schedule.
