1. How much was the contract preceding this one worth? What are the differences between the previous package and the new package?

The previous contract was VA261-13-F-0281 with a total amount of \$861,167.00. The previous contract only covered the three main hospital systems and not the Community Based Outpatient Clinics.

2. According to the package the San Jose CBOC will not be included in this package, however section 1.3 indicates that San Jose is on the list for work order services. Furthermore, the article states, "When the location opens for services, it will be handled in a future bilateral modification. The anticipated start date is October 1, 2017...", does this mean that SJ CBOC has already gone through this process or would the company awarded the new contract have to submit to this modification?

We would work with the company awarded the new contract in a bilateral contract modification.

3. In article 5.1, numbers 10 and 14, the contract indicates that inspection and treatment of WDO's are included within the scope of general services, is this correct?

Yes, that is correct.

4. Is there a particular certification process for the SVDOSB Certification or is this self – certification with military paperwork?
