

**DEPARTMENT OF VETERAN AFFAIRS
STATEMENT OF NEED**

A. GENERAL INFORMATION

- (1) Scope: The Contractor shall provide all resources necessary to accomplish the deliverables described in this statement of need, except as may otherwise be specified. The Contractor shall provide one (1) MRI Anesthesia Machine and all associated accessories. Installation, system configuration implementation, and training for end-users and Biomedical Engineering personnel shall also be provided.
- (2) Background: The NFSGVHS is seeking to purchase an MRI Anesthesia Machine for use in the MRI suites. The current MRI Suites are 3T and the anesthesia machine must be compatible.

B. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- (1) The contractor shall provide all labor, equipment, tools, materials, supervision, and other items necessary to deliver, setup, and configure/implement the MRI Anesthesia Machine for the MRI suite.
- (4) **SYSTEM TESTING**: Contractor shall test all equipment after setup.
- (5) **TRAINING AND SIMULATION**:
 - a. Contractor shall provide onsite competency training on the operation of monitors and telemetry transport system to thirty (30) anesthesiology employees during morning and evening shifts over a 2-day period. Training shall also include simulation exercises with all employee disciplines that will operate the equipment.

C. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES: The Contractor shall be responsible for the following:

- (1) Contractor shall provide qualified personnel for setup and integration.
- (2) Contractor shall be responsible for all system/software testing after setup and integration prior to Government final acceptance.
- (3) Contractor is responsible for ensuring the proper disposal of all debris generated from their activities.
- (4) Contractor is responsible for securing all materials, equipment and tools while on Government property or in the Government facility. The Government is not liable for any lost or stolen items that are not properly secured.

E. GOVERNMENT RESPONSIBILITIES: The Government will provide the following:

- (1) Provide site access and escorts through work areas as needed.

- (2) Provide primary electrical power.
- (3) Provide adequate space for the system equipment.
- (4) Ensure power and data ports are active.
- (5) Identify and provide representatives for walk through and sign off on installation when complete.

F. OTHER CONSIDERATIONS:

- (1) **PLACE OF PERFORMANCE:** Malcom Randall VA Medical Center, Gainesville, Florida.
- (2) **WORK HOURS:** Operational Hours are 0730-1700, Monday-Friday
- (3) **DELIVERY:** All deliveries shall be coordinated before arrival. Failure to coordinate delivery will be grounds to refuse delivery.
