- Bid Guarantee & Payment/Performance Bonds: IAW FAR 52.228-15, offerors are reminded that any award amount exceeding \$150,000.00 shall require a bid bond. This acquisition shall require both Payment and Performance Bonds. All bonds are due no later than 10 calendar days after award.
- Contractor shall begin performance within 5 days after Notice To Proceed (NTP) and complete within 270 days.
- Post Award Compliance:
