As Required		Used when a deficiency is noted which must be rectified.
Aseptic		Free from contamination caused by harmful bacteria, viruses, or other microorganisms. (of surgical practice) aiming at the complete exclusion of harmful microorganisms.
Bio-Science East	BSE	Bio-Science East is a leased building north of the PVN parking structure. It is mainly used as a clinical staff training facility.
Bi-Weekly		Twice monthly or "every other week".
Clinic Building Central	CBC	Also referred to as Building E. This building is located on the Center of the RMRVAMC Concourse spine.
Clinic Building North	CBN	Also referred to as Building G. This building is located on the Northwest side of the RMRVAMC Concourse spine.
Clinic Building South	CBS	Also referred to as Building A. This building is located at the South end of the RMRVAMC Concourse spine.

De-Commissioning will occur on a building by building basis until Also referred to as Building F. This is a U shaped building located on the Eastside of the RMRVAMC Concourse spine. It is connected to Building D., DAT (South).
Diagnostics and Testing - North	DAT (North)	Also referred to as Building D. This is a U shaped building located on the Eastside of the RMRVAMC Concourse spine. It is connected to Building F., DAT (North).
Diagnostics and Testing - South	DAT (South)	Stand-alone building located at the North-end of the Concourse Building. Provides all of the energy needs for the RMRVAMC hospital facility. It is where FMS, Facilities

Loading Dock Area	LDA	The loading dock area is an underground structure located at the North-end of the Concourse Building. It is under the PVN, Parking Visitor North Building.
Main Level Concourse	MAINCON	The 1st or Main Level of the RMRVAMC Concourse spine. Patient and staff access points to the hospital are located on the Main Level. The Main Level Concourse Walkway is Staff Parking structure north of the RMRVAMC Facility. It is across N. 17th Place and is connected via an enclosed pedestrian bridge to the Concourse Building Main Level
Parking Staff North Building	PSN	Northern most building connected to the Concourse Building spine. Above ground it is the Spinal Cord Injury Handicapped Parking Structure. Below ground is the Loading Dock Area, Underground parking structure north of the CBS Building, Building A. It is below the south entrance deck.
Parking Visitor North Building	PVN	The RMRVAMC Facility Coffee Shop. Located at the north end of the Concourse Building on the main level. Normal operating hours are from 0700-1630 hours.
Parking Visitor South	PVS	The cafeteria operated as the main eatery for the RMRVAMC Facility. Located at the south end of the Concourse Building on the main level. Normal operating hours are from 0700-1630 hours.
Patriot Brew		The RMRVAMC Facility Shopping Mart. Located toward the north end of the Concourse Building main level. Normal operating hours are from 0700-1630 hours.
