4.1 Registered Radiology Technologist/ Computed Tomography ARRT RT (R)(CT)

4.1.1 RT(R)(CT) Technologists are responsible for the performance of diagnostic radiology procedures and to perform the full complement of exams.

4.1.2 Must be fully competent to operate a Toshiba Aquillion 160 Multi-slice scanners or similar type of equipment, and to perform the full complement of contrast and non-contrast exams generated by this technology, as demonstrated by past work experience.
