1. <u>Contracting Activity</u>: Department of Veterans Affairs, Network Contracting Office 21, on behalf of VA Palo Alto Health Care System (VAPAHCS).

- 2. Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed: This justification and approval is to support an out-of-scope contract modification to extend the term of the contract by two (2) months to August 31st, 2018. The value of the contract extension is \$317,567.15.
- 3. <u>Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs</u>: The requirement is to provide home oxygen services for Veteran beneficiaries within the VA Palo Alto Health Care System service territory. The volumes or amounts shown in the schedule are estimates only. The contractor shall provide all required supplies, materials, labor, supervision, transportation, patient education, and safety management and infection control. The service supports the hospital's P&SAS department. The contract modification is to extend the existing contract while a long-term contract is being established.

Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority): Only One Responsible Source and No Other Supplies or Services Will Satisfy Agency Requirements (FAR 6.302-1) – Home oxygen services are currently being provided by Apria Healthcare. Competing a bridge contract extension could potentially cause severe delays in delivering service. At this time, Apria Healthcare, LLC, a large business, is the only firm capable of providing the necessary supplies and services described in Section III above in a timely manner, without the Veteran's Health Administration experiencing unacceptable or severe delays in fulfilling its requirements. The purpose of this contract modification is to extend the existing contract while a long-term contract is being established.

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- 5. Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable: Concurrently with this short-term contract extension, VISN 21 is seeking a long-term contract for same service (612-17-1-905-0001), which is being routed through the formal VHA contract review process, as required in cases of services contracts in excess of \$500K. Action taken to achieve maximum competition will be achieved through the new VISN-21-wide contract that is currently being processed.
- 6. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable: The Contracting Officer has determined that the anticipated price for this out-of-scope contract modification will utilize the same monthly rates as those stated in current contract. These rates have already been determined fair and reasonable prior to contract award.
- 7. Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted: As described in Section VI above, market research, in accordance with FAR Part 10, was conducted by synopsis of the proposed acquisition, advising industry of the pending acquisition and soliciting inquiries from interested parties. However, only one source is capable of providing continuity of service at this time for the bridge contract extension: Apria Healthcare, LLC.
- 8. Any Other Facts Supporting the Use of Other than Full and Open Competition: This is contemplated to be an out-of-scope contract modification to extend the term of the contract for two (2) months, in order to provide the needed supplies and services to VA patient beneficiaries, only for the duration of time that the new VISN 21 procurement action is pending award.
- 9. Listing of Sources that Expressed, in Writing, an Interest in the Acquisition: Apria Healthcare, LLC
- 10. A Statement of the Actions, if any, the Agency May Take to Remove or Overcome any Barriers to Competition before Making subsequent acquisitions for the supplies or services required: A five-year competitive contract action is currently going through formal VHA contract review procedures and will seek to maximize competition. This out-of-scope contract modification action will aid in the efforts of completing the five-year contract by extending existing contract with current incumbent, thereby allowing the VHA additional time to complete the VISN-wide contract action.
