3. **Description of Supplies or Services:** Purchase of 13 Versacare Medical Surgical Beds to be used in the new CLC (Building 80) at the NMVAHCS. This unit is designated as a Hospice/Palliative care unit which will require beds that meet the requirements for caring for patients at end of life.

The estimated value of the proposed action is \$148,004.22

These beds have lowchair positions, point-of-care siderails controls, slide guard pivot technology, hands free foot controls for bed height, audible brake alarms, amsart bed read, flexafoot adjustable bed length, battery backup, stationary height headboard, line-of-site angle indicators, cord wrap clips with IV pole storage, drainage bag holders, night light, four IV sockets, tuckaway siderails with oneStep siderail release, patient controls backlighting, bed controls in siderail, urethane central locking caster system, one-step Emergency CPR and Trendelenburg Release mechanism. Included options: English language labels, Voltage 120, in bed-scale displays kilograms and pounds; P500 Wound surge with MCM, 5" caster, patient position monitoring/bed exit system, light neutral end panels, patient helper adapter-headend, safeview alert, and IV pole.

5. Rational/explanation to support cited authority:

6. Hill-Rom beds are used at the NMVAHCS. Two Hill-Rom Versare Medical Surgical Beds have been purchased for the new CLC (Building 80) in August 27, 2017. It is critical that the same bed model be used for the remainder 13 beds in the new CLC. Having different models would be a patient safety concern and could lead to an adverse patient event.

7. **BRAND NAME ONLY:** This buy is estimated to exceed \$25,000 and this documentation will be posted along with the RFQ on e-Buy, as required by FAR 8.405-1(e).
8. Note that this determination satisfies the requirements of FAR 8.405-6. The requirement to prepare a written justification IAW FAR 6.303 does not apply to Federal Supply Schedules.
