Projects assigned will vary in type and magnitude and include, but are not limited to: Replacement of quadruplex booster pump skid in building 58; replacement of associated controls and upgrades to remote control and monitoring features; replacement of triplex booster pump skid in building 52; replacement of Sitrans water metering equipment at various locations. replacement of domestic water heaters; installation of thermostatic mixing valves at various locations; installation of battery power sensor operated faucets at several existing sink locations; installation of water quality monitoring equipment at incoming water service and end of line points. Water monitoring to be networked to VA engineering network. removal of dead leg piping at various locations; and installation of backflow preventers at various locations

guarantee due at time of solicitation closing. Address to send original bid bonds is located on page 11 of solicitation. If original bid guarantee is not received by the solicitation closing date and time, proposal will be late and will not be considered.

- Contractor shall begin performance within 5 days after Notice To Proceed (NTP) and complete within 270 days.
