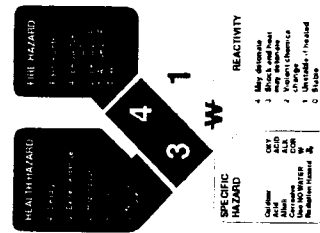

FIRE PROCEDURES (R.A.C.E.)

- R RESCUE** Rescue persons in immediate danger
- A ALARM** Pull nearest pull station and dial 2555
- C CONFINE** Close all doors to contain smoke
- E EXTINGUISH** Extinguish the fire using the correct extinguisher, if a small fire.

USE OF FIRE EXTINGUISHER (P.A.S.S.)

- P PULL** Pull the pin
- A AIM** Aim the nozzle at the base of the fire
- S SQUEEZE** Squeeze the handle
- S SWEEP** Sweep the nozzle from side to side across the base of the fire

HAZARDOUS MATERIAL

1. Contain spill
2. Isolate area
3. For minor spills, check MSDS sheet, follow instructions
4. For major spills, dial 2555
5. For radiation incidents, dial 7558/7559 - irregular hours, dial 2555

EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBERS MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND UTILITIES

For the following utility emergencies, contact work control, dial 2932/2924/7075

- Electrical Failure • Elevator Failure
- Air Conditioning/Refrigeration • Heating • Water
- Medical Air Vacuum

For medical equipment emergencies, dial pager 333 ext. 2924/7075. For communication emergencies, dial 2591. NOTE: During irregular hours contact the boiler plant, dial 7929. Know where your service specific utility failure plan is located.
