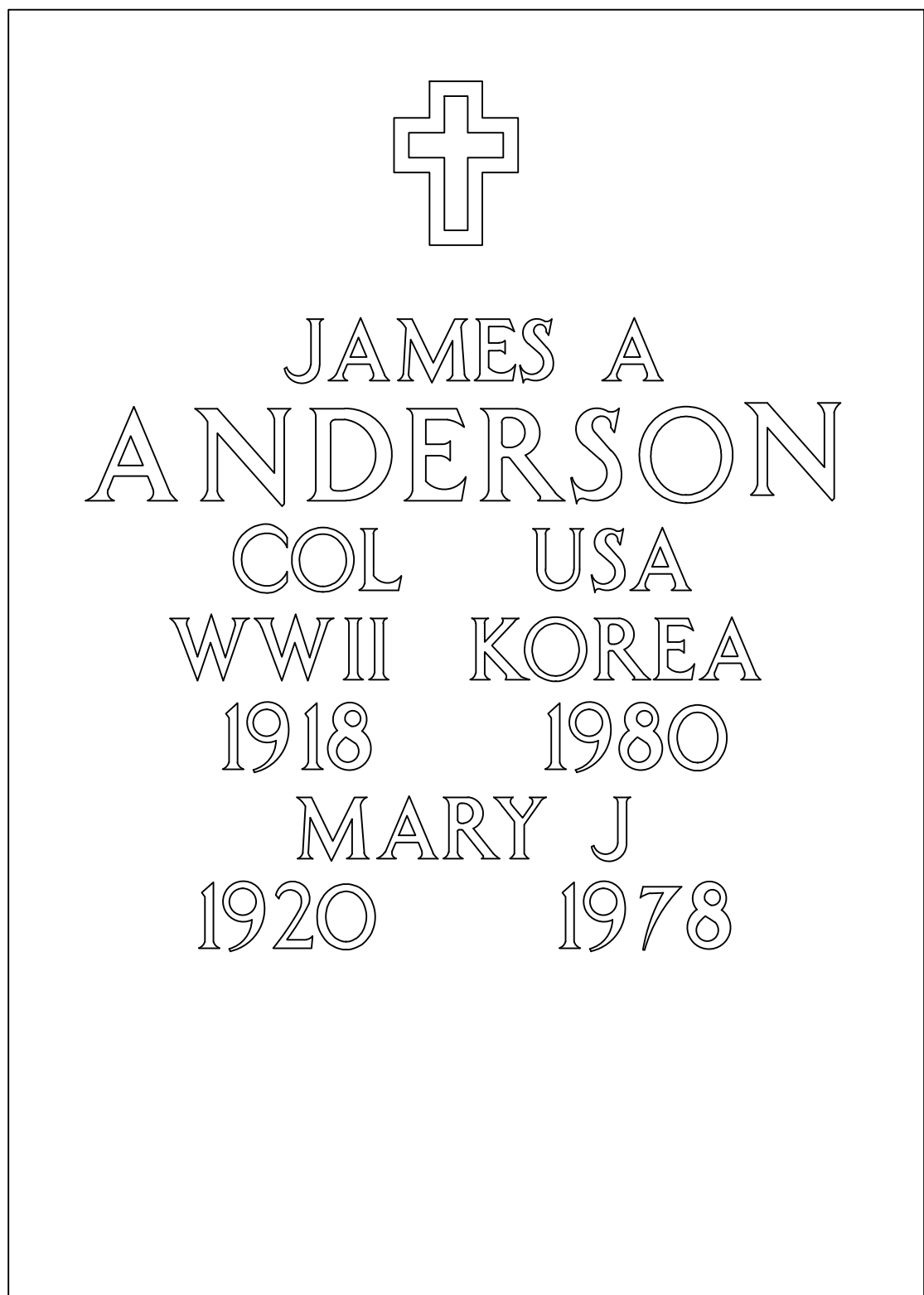

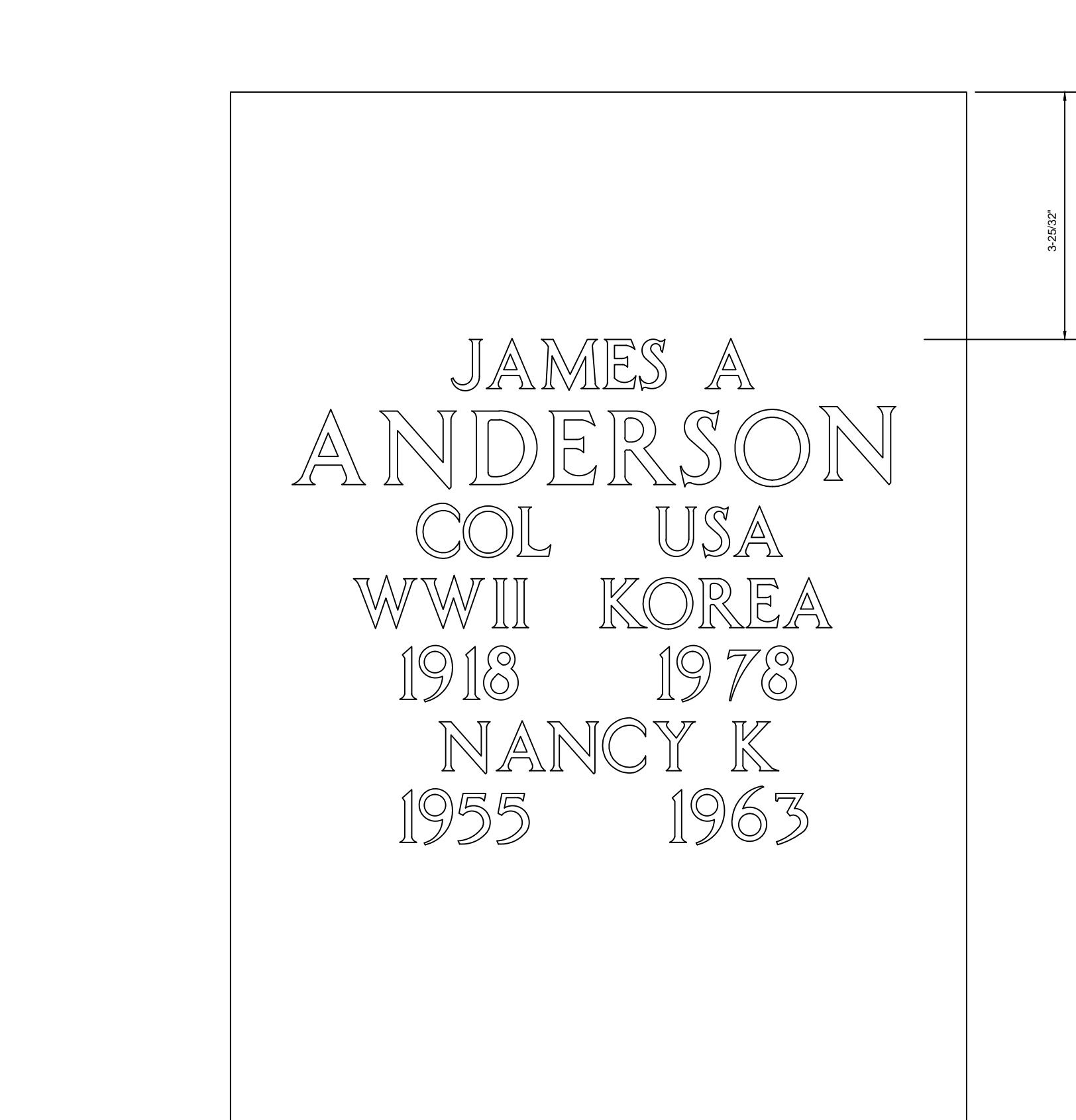

GENERAL NOTES:

4. The space between the Date of Birth and Date of Death shall be 2" and centered horizontally on marker face.
5. The space between the Rank and Branch of Service shall be 1 1/2" and centered horizontally on marker face.
6. The space between two Emblems of Belief shall be 5" and centered horizontally on marker face.
7. For niche covers E1, H1, and I1 reference drawing(s) AL-FN&OC-1/2/3 for font specifications and inscription depth.

SCENARIO NO. 1 - The veteran predeceased the non-veteran spouse.
SCENARIO NO. 2 - The veteran predeceased non-veteran spouse (Scenario No. 1). The spouse is then subsequently inured with the veteran. The spouse's given name and years of birth and death are then field inscribed.
SCENARIO NO. 3 - The non-veteran spouse predeceased the veteran. The veteran's given name, rank and branch are inscribed at the time of interment of the spouse. Spouse is provided to inscribe the veteran's years of birth and death, and war periods, in the future.
SCENARIO NO. 4 - The non-veteran spouse predeceased the veteran. The death is then subsequently interred with the spouse. The veteran's years of birth and death are field inscribed.
SCENARIO NO. 5 - The veteran predeceased the veteran spouse. The surviving veteran given name, rank and branch of service are also inscribed for veteran recognition.

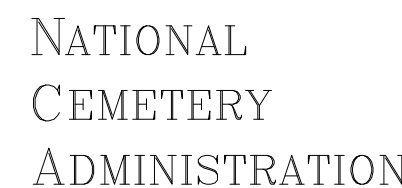
SCENARIO No. 6 - The veteran predeceased the veteran's spouse. The veteran's spouse is then subsequently interred with the veteran. The second veteran's years of birth and death and war periods are then field inscribed.

SCENARIO No. 7 - A dependent child predeceased the veteran and spouse. The veteran's given name, rank and branch are inscribed at the time of the dependent's interment. Space is provided for later addition of years of birth and death and war periods for the veteran.

SCENARIO No. 8 - A dependent child predeceased the veteran and the spouse. The veteran was subsequently interred with the dependent child. The veteran's years of birth and death and war periods are then field inscribed.

SCENARIO No. 9 - This is the same scenario as Scenario No.16, however, there is no En
