Brief Description of Supplies/ Services required and the intended use/Estimated Amount:** Depuy Synthes Small Fragment Locking Compression Plate LCP System to be used in selective trauma surgical procedures that involve the fixation of fractures including the clavicle, scapula, humerus, pelvis, distal tibia and/or fibula.
- 3. Unique characteristics that limit availability to only one source, with the reason no other supplies or services can be used:** The surgical sets are proprietary, since the implant sets only work with Depuy Synthes instrument packages. The requested items are being ordered to work in conjunction with existing and new surgical packages for continuity. Irrecoverable cost would be incurred by the Government should alternate manufacturer/system packages be implemented in this acquisition.
- 4. Description of market research conducted and results or statement why it was not conducted:** Limited market research was conducted due to the proprietary nature of the devices being ordered; however, an Intent to Sole Source was posted to FBO with no results.
