1. **Contracting Activity:** Department of Veterans Affairs, VISN 4, Wilmington VA Medical Center
2. **Brief Description of Supplies/ Services required and the intended use/Estimated Amount:**
The purpose of this system is the continually monitor a patient and providing their physiologic platform. This would allow providers to adapt to the patient needs and intervene when conditions have declined. The total cost of this request is: \$62,370.00.
3. **Unique characteristics that limit availability to only one source, with the reason no other supplies or services can be used:**
The EV1000 Advanced Monitoring Platform is the only platform available globally that has the capability of providing patient clinical status by having the option of either minimally invasive or non-invasive methods. The two options are by way of Min-Invasive FloTrac Arterial Transducer or the Non-Invasive ClearSight Finger Cuff. There is no other platform that provides the dual capability.
4. **Description of market research conducted and results or statement why it was not conducted:**
VIP shows that no SDVOSBs exist within the keyword search "EV1000" but there are FPDS examples of VA SDVOSBs set-asides with only one offer received, from 1st America Medical Dist. There are peripherals and accessories for these items on GSA and the NAC under contract with SDVOSBs.
