

1. Introduction:

The Government has a requirement for the purchase of multi-purpose seating for the G.V. (Sonny) Montgomery VA Medical Center. This scope of work will be performed at the Department of Veteran Affairs, 1500 E. Woodrow Wilson Dr., Jackson, MS 39216.

2. Scope

The project scope includes the purchase and installation 600 guest chairs and 700 task chairs for the VA Medical Center. All furniture within project scope is to be installed by vendor.

The contractor shall furnish all supplies, equipment, and expertise necessary to perform the delivery and installation of all furniture. The contractor shall be responsible for any missing parts and components not included in order to carry out the installation.

3. Specifications/Characteristics:

- Furniture must have lifetime warranty
- Furniture must be Greenguard or SCS Indoor Advantage Gold for Indoor Air Quality and FSC certified to substantiate the LEED Materials & Resources Credit 7 for Certified Wood and have BIFMA Level Certification
- Upholstery must be commercially rated and meet NFPA 701

4. Delivery/Other Requirements:

- Provide photographs of each item
- Delivery and installation scheduling will need to be coordinated with VA COR and end users.
- Preferred form of communications is email.
- Products will need to be scheduled for delivery once arrived and inspected.
- The product delivery is 8 weeks after contract award
- A project manager or project designer and installation foreman must be onsite during installation.
- Secure VA Badge and security clearance for all contractors, scheduled through VAMC Human Resources.
- Leave all work areas in clean and orderly condition.

- Install should be coordinated at least 2 weeks in advance with VA Interior Designer.
- Contractor Furnished Materials. This term refers to all labor, materials, and equipment to perform the job. When "furnish," "provide," "install," or a similar term is used, it shall mean complete installation, ready for use.
- Smoking Policy. The Contractor shall not allow smoking in any building. Smoking is only permitted in designated outdoor areas, 25 feet away from buildings.
- Place of Performance: G.V.(Sonny) Montgomery VA Medical Center, Jackson, MS or local leased space.
- Items to be received and stored at vendor warehouse for up to 90 days due to project completions.
- Delivery will be made on up to 10 different selected dates.
- The Contractor shall perform all work during normal business hours (Monday-Friday, 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM), unless otherwise stipulated by the COR.
