- 2. Description of Action:** The Gulf Coast Veterans Health Care System (GCVHCS), Pathology & Laboratory Medicine Service (P&LMS), is in the process of renovating the entire laboratory. The Hematology and Urinalysis Department of PL&MS has five analyzers that must be temporarily relocated from one room to another during this phase of renovations. This will be awarded as a new requirement, firm-fixed-price contract.

3. Description of Supplies or Services:

This request is to move five analyzers, Models: LH750, LH500, IRIS and Velocity, from Bldg. 3, Room 3B103, to Bldg. 3, Room 3A105B. This will require the equipment to be disassembled in one area and reassembled in another area. These analyzers are leased from Beckman Coulter. Beckman Coulter is responsible for all maintenance and services performed on this equipment. They will have engineers on-site to move the equipment.

4. Authority:

5. Rational/explanation to support cited authority:

The relocating of the equipment must be completed by Beckman Coulter engineers so there will be no disruption in services. They hold proprietary rights to the equipment and do not have authorized dealers or subcontractors capable of providing these services. It is in the best interest of the government to have Beckman Coulter provide the requested services in order to maintain standardization and warranty.
