

## **STATEMENT OF WORK (SOW) REGULATORY FUND SCAQMD RULE 2202**

### **INTRODUCTION**

Contractor shall provide Regulatory Fund South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Rule 2202 for the VA Greater Los Angeles Healthcare System (VAGLAHS) located at 11301 Wilshire Blvd., Los Angeles, CA 90873. The Contractor shall provide all necessary and appropriate all resources necessary to perform the services requested herein and in accordance to the Statement of Work (SOW).

### **BACKGROUND**

The VA Greater Los Angeles Healthcare System (VAGLAHS) is regulated by South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) a regulatory agency responsible for controlling emissions from stationary sources such as government installations, commercial businesses and residences. SCAQMD enforces air pollution regulations under federal and state law to ensure air quality standards are met.

### **SCOPE**

In accordance with SCAQMD Rule 2202 – On-Road Motor Vehicle Mitigation Options, VAGLAHS has developed and implemented emission reduction strategy. The program allows our facility to meet the designated emission reduction target while complying with the ambient air quality standard mandated by the Federal and State Clean Air Act, Health and Safety Code Section 40458, and Section 182(d)(1)(B) of the Federal Clean Air Act. To ensure full compliance with Rule 2202 VAGLAHS has a requirement for emission credit transfer and rideshare matching database.

### **SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS**

- a. The Contractor shall transfer emission credits to VAGLAHS in accordance with SCAQMD Rule 2202. All required documentation shall be provided by the Contractor in order to meet the compliance due date for the plan and fees on or before January 06, 2019.
- b. The Contractor shall file and submit the final Air Quality Management District report to SCAQMD on behalf of VAGLAHS in a timely manner.
- c. The Contractor shall establish and maintain a web -based transportation (carpool) tracking and rideshare matching database certified by SCAQMD. The emission reduction strategy is to comply with meeting the average vehicle ridership (AVR) performance goal of 1.5 AVR by pairing employees for carpooling/vanpooling. The database shall include the following:
  - i. Customized survey with privacy and confidentiality guaranteed.
  - ii. Commute portal for enabling ride matching and other rideshare facilities for employee commutes.
  - iii. Provide incentive tracker for employee's daily commutes.
  - iv. Provide online progress reports on program usage and tracking.
  - v. Provide links to local public transit information, vanpools, etc.
  - vi. Provide instant match lists for potential carpoolers based on location and personal preferences.

**APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS, STANDARDS, LAWS, AND /OR REGULATIONS:**

Contractor is solely responsible for meeting any current or future requirements approvals or certification as may be levied by applicable legal, regulatory, accrediting body, governing body, and/or local/state/federal requirements as required by law. Due to continuous regulatory changes in both federal and state laws, the contractor shall be in compliance of new regulations within thirty (30) calendar days of notification.

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
