RFI #1 - III CONTENTS OF TECHNICAL PROPOSAL: FACTOR 1: EXPERIENCE ON SIMILAR ABATEMENT AND REMEDIATION CONTRACTS - For this section may we utilize Key Personnel Experience?

VA Response to RFI Question #1 – The offeror may not submit Key Personnel experience as it is not required or asked for in the solicitation. The solicitation only requires experience of a prime licensed abatement contractor for successfully completed projects. Key Personnel experience will not be considered for evaluation.

RFI #2 - III CONTENTS OF TECHNICAL PROPOSAL: FACTOR 1: EXPERIENCE ON SIMILAR ABATEMENT AND REMEDIATION CONTRACTS - For this section may we utilize/submit Subcontractor Experience?

VA Response to RFI Question #2 – The offeror may not utilize/submit subcontractor experience. Experience must reflect past contracts completed by the prime abatement contractor successfully completed by the prime contractor. Subcontractor experience would not reflect direct abatement experience as a prime abatement contractor, thus it will not be considered for evaluation.

RFI #3 - If we are a Licensed General Contractor (A&B in State of CA) and have teamed with a licensed abatement, subcontractor, may we submit their license under Section II of the Price Proposal?

VA Response to RFI Question #3 – The license submitted must be from a licensed abatement contractor. The prime contractor must be the licensed abatement contractor. In summary, if a Licensed General Contractor teams with a licensed abatement, subcontractor and submits the license of the subcontractor, then the proposal would not meet the submission requirements and be considered non-responsive.

RFI #4 - Can you please extend the bid due time to 2:00pm PST?

VA Response to RFI Question #4 – The bid due time will not be extended to 2:00 P.M. PST.
