3. Instrument/Analyzer/Reagent Requirements

The contractor shall provide:

- a. The delivery, installation and use of the automated analyzer(s) for clot-based and photometric testing.
- b. The Operators' manual and a start-up box of accessories.
- c. Assistance to method verification following initial installation.
- d. All necessary supplies to perform coagulation tests that are currently being used on a Stago Compact Max with Cap Piercing analyzers, including but, not limited to:

– STA CaCl ₂ (0.025M)	– STA-Mini Reducer Plastic inserts for reagents
– STA PTT A 5	– Liquid filter
– STA Neoplastine CI Plus 10	– Needle 1 for cap piercing
– STA Coag Control N+ABN Plus	– Needle 2
– STA Maxi-Reducer	– Suction rubber head
– STA Cleaner Solution	– Needle 3
– STA Desorb U	– Teflon syringe tip and O-Ring kit
– STA Cuvettes	– Halogen lamp
– STA-Microcontainer Plastic cups for samples	– Hamilton syringe and o-ring
